- Between 300 and 600 bottles from each cask, 70cl bottles
- Bottled mainly at 46% abv, and occasionally at cask strength
- Not coloured, nor chill-filtered
- The range celebrates the contrasting appeals of different whisky regions, including Speyside, Highland, Islay, Campbeltown and Lowlands
- Named after the natural taste and aroma of the character in each cask
